

How-to for Friends of Backyard Buoys (BB):

To share their Spotter/Smart Mooring data on the BB smartphone app

Completing the steps below will allow your real-time data to show up in the Backyard Buoys smartphone app. The app serves the latest week of data, but the data is not archived.

- Create an account on the Backyard Buoys Dashboard: <u>https://dashboard.backyardbuoys.org/signin.php</u>. You will receive an email (within 1-2 days) confirming that your account has been set up and given permission to add buoys to the Dashboard. Log in to the Dashboard using the same link above.
- Use the + button in the upper left hand corner to add an "Area". An area is defined as your named deployment location, the space you intend to occupy for a period of time (maybe continuously) even if the physical buoy deployed their changes. Complete all required fields in the area form. Some notes:
 - a. The "Label" is the location name as you would like it to appear on the Backyard Buoys smartphone app.
 - b. If you do not see your "Group" in the dropdown menu, please email Troy Tanner (<u>troyt@apl.uw.edu</u>) to have it added.
 - c. The "Center Latitude", "Center longitude", and "Radius" of the area are used to dynamically determine which deployed buoy is located within the bounds of an area.
- 3. Use the + button to add a "Buoy". A buoy is defined by its SPOT ID number. Complete all required fields and as many optional fields as possible in the buoy form. Some notes:
 - a. Be sure to select "Yes" for "Display Data in Backyard Buoys App". As a friend of Backyard Buoys, the project will not be archiving your data.
